Harrison St-Oakland Ave Bikeway Project

DESCRIPTION

The City of Oakland is proposing to install

a new bikeway in the Harrison St-Oakland Ave corridor from Grand Ave to the Piedmont border. The project would install bicycle striping and markings and wayfinding signs that provide destination and distance information (example, right).




The project is recommended in the City's Bicycle Master Plan (BMP) and in the Harrison St/Oakland Ave Community Transportation Plan that was completed in 2010, following a year-long community process. This Plan creates a long-term vision for calming traffic along

Harrison St and Oakland Ave to improve the livability of the neighborhoods between Lake Merritt and the Piedmont border. (For more information see www.tinyurl.com/4wxmjt2.)

The bikeway project is planned for completion in 2011. It would be funded by State Transportation Development Act Article 3 grant funds and Oakland's share of Measure B Bicycle/Pedestrian Program funds, Alameda County's half-cent transportation sales tax. Both fund sources use tax revenues solely dedicated to bicycle and pedestrian projects.

The BMP calls for the installation of bikeways throughout Oakland to encourage bicycling as a healthy, non-polluting and affordable transportation option, helping Oakland to realize its sustainability and livability goals.



FEASIBILITY & SAFETY

The project would install both bike lanes and shared roadway bicycle markings (aka "sharrows," pictured below) along the corridor. To make room for bike lanes, one travel lane would be removed on Harrison St from MacArthur Blvd to Fairmount Ave. Sharrows would be installed on Harrison St from Bayo Vista Ave to MacArthur Blvd, and Fairmount Ave to Grand Ave. Sharrows encourage bicyclists to ride clear of the "door zone," and advise motorists to expect and share the road with bicyclists. Potential traffic impacts were studied as part of the Harrison St/Oakland Ave Community Transportation Plan. The evaluation showed that the lane removal will not have significant impacts on motor vehicle traffic flow, either now or 20 years in the future. The project does not affect on-street parking in the corridor.

GEOGRAPHIC CONTEXT

The Harrison St-Oakland Ave Bikeway
Project would complete a 1.2-mile link in the
City's bikeway network, connecting to existing bikeways on Harrison St, Grand Ave, and
Oakland Ave. A bikeway was installed on
Oakland Ave from Orange St to Santa Clara
Ave in August 2009. The project will also
connect to a bikeway pending construction
on 27th St/Bay Place from Grand Ave to San
Pablo Ave. These new bikeways would improve
access between the lower hills neighborhoods,
Lake Merritt, the 19th St BART Station and
downtown. See Project Area Map, left.








Harrison St, Bayo Vista Ave-MacArthur Blvd
