Notes on Item # 6. Lake Merritt BART Station Area Plan

Ed Manasse and Christina Ferracane of the Strategic Planning Department will present the Community Preferred Alternative for the Lake Merritt Station Area Plan. They will summarize transportation proposals, highlighting any changes to the proposal since they were presented to the BPAC earlier this year. They will ask for feedback from the BPAC on the Preferred Alternative, ahead of presentations to other advisory boards, the Planning Commission and City Council, and ahead of finalizing the proposals that will be analyzed in an Environmental Impact Report.

Chapters 6 and 7 describe the streetscape character, circulation, access and parking strategies. Page 7-6 incorrectly describes the proposed bikeways in the Bicycle Master Plan.
