SUMMARY

Staff received a request from the Medicine Warrior Dance Troupe & All Nation's for permission to allow arts craft and food vendors at their 10th Annual Powwow at Clinton Park on Saturday, September 13, 2008.

BACKGROUND

This is the Medicine Warrior Dance Troupe's tenth year utilizing Clinton Park for their annual powwow. They came before the PRAC for the last three years and were granted permission to allow craft and food vendors. All events have been successful and went as planned.

These groups are a vital part of Indian Spiritual life at Intertribal Friendship House and the Bay Area. The dance troupe encourages and supports traditional Indian dancing for youth of all ages. Providing a tangible way to promote self-esteem, health and help for families. The work of the Medicine Warriors Dance Troupe extends beyond Oakland to the larger Indian community of the Bay Area, with families, dancers and drummers coming from San Mateo, San Francisco and Vallejo to attend dance classes in Oakland.

Medicine warrior Dance Troupe & All Nations 9th Annual Powwow will again be at Clinton Park, just next to Intertribal Friendship House, transforming for one day that lovely but sometimes dangerous place to a safe, friendly and happy place for families and for all people. The powwow reclaims the use of the park for dancing and for healing. With your permission for craft and food vendors to sell their arts and crafts and Native American foods, the Medicine Warriors Dance troupe & All Nations 9th annual Powwow will be as successful and fulfilling as it was last year. Thank you very much. To add a comment from last year's 2007 Pow Wow made by an Oakland Park Ranger who stated "if we had more weekly events in the community the crime rate would be reduced by larger numbers." Our committee was honored to hear this from our Park Rangers. We've received many positive comments from Oakland residents. Thank You to all of our Oakland neighbors!
