

## **Important February 25<sup>th</sup> Public Hearing for the Oakland Hills Community**

The Wildfire Prevention District (WPAD) board will hold a Public Hearing to discuss development of a District-wide Vegetation Management Plan for effective wildland fire prevention in the hills. The need for such a plan was unanimously endorsed at a WPAD community workshop by a variety of stakeholders in early 2015.

A consulting firm has recently been awarded a City contract with appropriated funds to develop a District-wide Vegetation Management Plan.

The WPAD invites the community to a Public Hearing and review of the 2015 WPAD workshop input with the purpose of presenting a final report to the Council on what did and didn't work with the current Wildfire Prevention District and recommendations for organizing another wildfire prevention district in the future, following completion of the Vegetation Management Plan for Fire Risk Reduction in the Oakland Hills.
