**A. REQUEST APPROVAL TO ALLOW AMERICAN FOUNDATION FOR  
SUICIDE PREVENTION (AFSP) TO SOLICIT ONSITE CHARITABLE  
DONATIONS FROM SUPPORTERS AT THEIR OUT OF DARKNESS SUICIDE  
PREVENTION WALK AT LAKESIDE PARK (PERGOLA) ON SATURDAY,  
OCTOBER 14, 2017.**

Oakland Parks & Recreation received a request from American Foundation for Suicide Prevention (AFSP), a non-profit organization that funds research to improve intervention, train clinicians in suicide prevention and advocate for policies that will save lives. AFSP is requesting to solicit onsite charitable donations from supporters at their Out of Darkness Walk at Lakeside Park (Pergola) on Saturday, October 14, 2017, from 6:00AM-10:00AM. 100% of the donations collected will benefit prevention and education about suicide with 50% of the funds retained locally for crisis support in the Bay Area. Approval from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission is required per O.M.C. section 12.64.080.

**B. REQUEST APPROVAL TO ALLOW EASTSIDE ARTS ALLIANCE  
PERMISSION COLLECT DONATIONS AND AUTHORIZED VENDORS TO  
SELL FOOD AND MERCHANDISE AT THE MALCOLM X JAZZ FESTIVAL  
IN SAN ANTONIO PARK ON SATURDAY, MAY 20, 2017.**

Elena Serrano, Program Director for Eastside Arts Alliance (ESAA), contacted Oakland Parks & Recreation for permission to collect donations and allow vendor's to sell food and merchandise at the 17<sup>th</sup> Annual Malcolm X Jazz Festival in San Antonio Park on Saturday, May 20, 2017, from 7:00am – 6:30pm. The funds raised will be used to cover the costs of the festival, (i.e. stage rental, clean-up, tables/chairs, etc). Approval from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission is required per O.M.C. section 12.64.080.

## 7. NEW BUSINESS

### A. **REQUEST THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION APPROVE THE POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS ON DOGS IN OAKLAND PARKS.**

In August 2012, the Oakland Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission (PRAC) established an Ad Hoc Committee to address the issue of dogs in Oakland parks. Creation of the *Ad Hoc Committee on Dog Play Areas* was in response to public debate about how Oakland was addressing a growing demand for dog play areas in its parks. The Commission determined there was a need for the City to adopt a formal policy to guide future decisions about how and where to accommodate dogs in parks as Oakland's population, both canine and human, grows.

### B. **REQUEST APPROVAL TO ALLOW EAST BAY AGENCY FOR CHILDREN TO SOLICIT ONSITE CHARITABLE DONATIONS FROM SUPPORTERS AT THEIR CIRCLE OF CARE WALK TO REMEMBER AT LAKESIDE PARK ON SATURDAY, MAY 6, 2017.**

Oakland Parks & Recreation received a request from East Bay Agency for Children (EBAC), a non-profit organization whose mission is to improve the well-being of children, youth and families by reducing the impact of trauma and social inequities. EBAC is requesting to solicit onsite charitable donations from supporters at their Circle of Care Walk to Remember at Lakeside Park on Saturday, May 6, 2017, at 9:00AM-2:00PM. Donations from the event will directly support East Bay Agency for Children's grief and loss program that provides support services for children and families in Oakland. This is East Bay Agency for Children's third presentation before the Commission. Approval from the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission is required per O.M.C. section 12.64.080.

### C. **REQUEST APPROVAL TO ALLOW CARIBELINQ OMNIMEDIA LLC TO COLLECT VENDOR REGISTRATION FEES, AND TO AUTHORIZE VENDORS TO SELL FOOD, CONCESSIONS AND WARES AT THE OAKLAND CARNIVAL AT MOSSWOOD PARK ON JUNE 3, 2017.**

Oakland Parks, Recreation & Youth Development received a request from CaribelinQ OmniMedia LLC, a for profit organization, to utilize Mosswood Park for their Oakland Carnival event on June 3, 2017 from 8:00AM – 8:00PM. Organizers are requesting permission to collect registration fees from onsite vendors to create an African Marketplace and for approval of vendors to sell goods and food items. The goal of the Oakland Carnival is to bring African centered communities of culture together in the name of art music, dance and wellness.

**D. REQUEST APPROVAL TO ALLOW ARDOR OF HOPE PERMISSION TO COLLECT DONATIONS ONSITE FOR THEIR FUNDRAISING EVENT AT JACK LONDON AQUATIC CENTER ON SATURDAY, JUNE 10, 2017.**

Oakland Parks & Recreation received a request from Ardor of Hope, a nonprofit organization located in San Leandro, California to collect donations on site at their fundraising event on June 10, 2017 from 3:00PM – 9:00PM at Jack London Aquatic Center. Ardor of Hope was established to provide transitional housing for the reentry population, those released from prison into Oakland. Their focus is men from historically marginalized groups with a high rate of recidivism.

Oakland Parks, Recreation & Youth Development (OPRYD) has received a request from The Friends of Sausal Creek (FOSC) a proposal to support an Eagle Scout project to construct split rail fencing to protect redwood forest understory plantings along the Bridgeview Trail in Dimond Canyon Park.
